## Spring has sprung very early this year!

Maine experienced much warmer than normal temperatures this winter. The warmer temperatures gave us a lot more rain than snow, thus leaving the Belgrade Lakes Region a winter of little snow with poor ice conditions. Not a typical Maine winter for us!

The ice surface on Salmon Lake disappeared on March 19<sup>th</sup> giving us open water a month earlier than normal - we normally experience ice out the third week in April. The early open water will mean the fishing patterns Whisperwood Guests normally see when they plan their fishing trips around the same time each year could be different. Last year was a banner year for big fish caught by our guests. The cold rainy spring carried into the first part of July and kept the water temperature in a range were the fish were staying closer to shore. The Anglers were finding the fish easy to locate, making for some nice action on the water. We anticipate another **banner** year as well - take a look at the **Big Bass Page** on our website. With our catch, photograph & release policy all of those fish are back and a little bit bigger this year!

1 Day - \$ 13.00 (same as 2009)  
3 Day – \$25.00 (same as 2009)  
7 Day – \$45.00  
15 Day - \$49.00  
Season Adult – \$66.00  
Season Junior – \$18.00 (12-15 yrs. old)
